ORDER

UPON the Tribunal having made an Order on 29 September 2016 giving directions in respect of an application for disclosure by British Telecommunications plc (“BT”)

AND UPON considering the application by BT dated 14 October 2016 to withdraw its request for disclosure and for permission to amend its notice of appeal in light of information provided by the Competition and Markets Authority (“CMA”) regarding the basis for the CMA’s costs order in connection with the reference made in BT’s appeal in Case 1238/3/3/15

AND UPON reading the observations of the CMA dated 18 October 2016 and the agreed draft order dated 21 October 2016

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. BT is granted permission to amend its notice of appeal in light of disclosure and any further information provided by the CMA
2. BT file and serve its amended notice of appeal and any further supporting evidence by 5pm on 8 November 2016
3. The CMA file and serve its defence and supporting evidence by 5pm on 20 December 2016
4. The case management conference listed for 4 November 2016 be vacated

5. There be liberty to apply.
