ORDER

UPON reading the decision of the Office of Fair Trading (“OFT”) dated 22 October 2009 entitled “Response to CAMRA’s Super-complaint”

AND UPON reading the Notice of Application lodged by the Campaign for Real Ale (“CAMRA”) under Rules 8 and 25 of The Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2003 (S.I. No. 1372 of 2003) on 22 December 2009

AND UPON reading the request for permission to intervene from the British Beer and Pub Association (“BBPA”) dated 20 January 2010

AND UPON the parties indicating in correspondence that they are content for the Application to be stayed

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application be stayed until 1 August 2010;
