



COMPETITION APPEAL TRIBUNAL

**NOTICE OF A CLAIM FOR DAMAGES UNDER SECTION 47A OF
THE COMPETITION ACT 1998**

CASE No: 1166/5/7/10

The Registrar of the Competition Appeal Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) gives notice of the receipt of a claim for damages (the “Claim”) on 18 June 2010, under section 47A of the Competition Act 1998 (the “Act”), by Albion Water Limited of 71 Clarence Road, Teddington, Middlesex, TW11 0BN (the “Claimant”) against Dŵr Cymru Cyfyngedig (Welsh Water) of Pentwyn Road, Nelson, Treharris, Mid Glamorgan, CF46 6LY (the “Defendant”).

The Claimant’s legal advisers are Shepherd and Wedderburn LLP of Condor House, 10 St Paul’s Churchyard, London EC4M 8AL (Reference: A2546.2/GLH/JMYS).

The Claimant indicates that the Claim arises as a result of the findings made by the Tribunal in its judgments in Case No: 1046/2/4/04 *Albion Water Ltd & Albion Water Group Limited v Water Services Regulation Authority (formerly Director General of Water Services) (Dŵr Cymru/Shotton Paper)* in respect of abusive pricing practices engaged in by the Defendant in relation to the provision of non-potable water supplies to the Claimant.

The Claimant seeks damages and or a sum of money pursuant to section 47A(1)(a) and (b) of the Act, together with interest thereon:

- (a) compensatory damages and/or restitution;
- (b) aggravated damages;
- (c) exemplary damages; and
- (d) interest.

Further, the Claimant seeks an order that the Defendant pay to it the costs of the Claim.
