ORDER

UPON TalkTalk Telecom Group PLC (“TalkTalk”) lodging, on 15 October 2013, an appeal against the determination by the Office of Communications (“OFCOM”) contained in a statement issued on 15 August 2013 and entitled “Dispute between TalkTalk Telecom Group PLC and Openreach relating to whether Openreach offered MPF New Provide to TalkTalk on fair and reasonable terms and conditions”

AND UPON the Tribunal listing a first case management conference (the “CMC”) for 11 November 2013

AND UPON each of British Telecommunications plc and British Sky Broadcasting Limited (together, the “Proposed Interveners”) filing requests for permission to intervene in the appeal (the “Requests to Intervene”)

AND UPON TalkTalk notifying the Tribunal by way of letter dated 7 November 2013 that the parties are agreed that the appeal should be stayed pending consideration of certain issues by OFCOM, and the Proposed Interveners not objecting to that course

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The appeal be stayed until further order of the Tribunal

2. The CMC be vacated
3. The Proposed Intervenors be given leave to revise the Requests to Intervene in the event that the stay is lifted to reflect any change in circumstances at that time
4. There be liberty to apply
