UPON reading the submissions of the parties

AND UPON hearing the legal representatives of the parties at a case management conference held on 7 April 2005

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Under rule 18 of the Tribunal Rules, the proceedings be proceedings before a Tribunal in England and Wales.
2. The appellant shall identify which, if any, OFT witnesses it intends to cross examine, by 5.00pm on 14 April 2005.
3. The appellant shall file and serve a reply, together with any additional witness evidence upon which it intends to rely, by 5.00 pm on 21 April 2005.
4. Both the appellant and the defendant shall file and serve skeleton arguments by 5.00pm on 9 May 2005.
5. The appellant and the defendant shall agree a chronological bundle of documents containing those documents referred to in the notice of appeal, the defence, the

reply, the witness evidence, or otherwise, on which either party intends to rely before the Tribunal, such bundle to be filed and served by 5.00 pm on 9 May 2005.

6. The appellant and the defendant shall agree a bundle of authorities, such bundle to be filed and served by 5.00 pm on 10 May 2005.
7. A further case management conference be listed for 28 April 2005.
8. The main hearing be listed for 23 May 2005 and 24 May 2005.
9. Costs be reserved.
10. There be permission to apply.
