ORDER

UPON reading the requests for permission to intervene from: (i) T-Mobile (UK) Limited dated 15 June 2007; (ii) Hutchison 3G (UK) Limited dated 19 June; (iii) Orange Personal Communications Services Limited dated 22 June 2007 and (iv) Vodafone Limited dated 26 June 2007

AND UPON reading the letters from OFCOM dated 25 June 2007 and 27 June 2007 indicating that OFCOM does not object to the requests for permission to intervene

AND UPON O2 Limited not objecting to any of the requests for permission to intervene

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Time for Vodafone Limited requesting permission to intervene in the proceedings pursuant to Rule 15(2)(f) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2003 is extended retrospectively until 26 June 2007.
2. T-Mobile (UK) Limited, Hutchison 3G (UK) Limited, Vodafone Limited and Orange Personal Communications Services Limited are permitted to intervene in the proceedings pursuant to Rule 16 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2003.

3. Submission of statements of intervention be stayed until further Order.
4. There be permission to apply.
